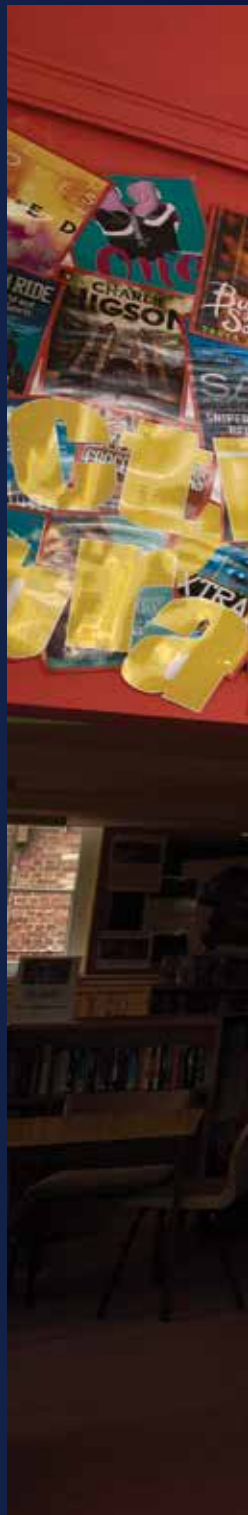
We offer a wide range of AS/A2 levels, vocational courses and the Diploma in Childcare and Education.
